Astrea	34	Cartagena	1756	Wrecked at La Carraca, Cadiz, on 1818
N S de la Asunción	34	Ferrol	1772	Wrecked at the coast of Buenos Aires, on may 20th, 1805. Only 23 men saved. Captain Juan Domingo Deslobbes
Colon	34	?	1780	Former british, captured by Cordoba's fleet. Run ashore at Cadiz bay in 1801.
N S de la O	34	La Habana	1778	Lost at Veracruz in 1805. Commanded by Cpt.Miguel de Palacios Ruiz.
N S del Rosario	34	El Ferrol	1770	Wrecked at waters off Catalunya in march 1793. Commanded by Cpt. Vicente Ferrer del Pomar.
Santa Agueda	34	La Habana	1776	Out of navy list in 1808.
Liebre	34	Cadiz	1775	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen.
N S del Carmen	34	El Ferrol	1770	Captured by the british at waters off Cadiz in 1800. Commanded by Cpt. Joaquin Porcel.
Santa Bibiana	34	?	1780	Former british, captured by Cordoba's fleet. Out of navy list at 1794
Santa Barbara	34	Guarnizo	1768	Lost nearby Juan Fernandez island in 1794.
Santa Cecilia	34	La Habana	1778	Chased by 2 british SoL near Trinidad, in february 1797, was burnt with Apocada's squadron. Commanded by Cpt. Manuel Urtezabel.
Santa Dorotea	34	El Ferrol	1775	Captured nearby Alicante by the british on july 15th, 1798. Commanded by Cpt. Manuel Guerrero y Seron.
Santa Lucia	34	La Habana	1770	Broke up at Cartage due to lack of careen.
Santa Magdalena	34	El Ferrol	1773	Wrecked at Vivero due to a storm, nov 2nd, 1810. Almost all crew died. Ctp. Blas Salcedo & Joaquin Zarans.
Santa Maria de la Cabeza	34	La Habana	1780	Lost at Manila in 1801, used to built a dock over. Under Alava's squadron.
Santa Matilde	34	La Habana	1778	Captured by a british frigate & SoL on oct 23rd, 1804 (beeing at peace), at waters off Cadiz. Cpt. Jose de la Guardia.
Santa Rosa	34	El Ferrol	1782	Broke up at Cartagena in 18007 due to lack of careen.
Santa Rosalia	34	Cartagena	1767	Broke up at Cadiz due to bad conditions by Royal Order march, 7th, 1803.
Santa Rufina	34	Cartagena	1777	Sunk at Cadiz by lack of careen on 1809
N S de Atocha	34	La Habana	1789	Burt at La Habana bay, ready to depart in 1810. Cpt. Lorenzo Jose de Noriega.
N S de la Paz	34	El Ferrol	1785	Wrecked by a storm at Cadiz, march 9th, 1810. Cpt. Rafael de Lobo.
N S del Pilar	34	El Ferrol	1782	Broke up at El Ferrol due to lack of careen in 1808.
N S de Guadalupe	34	La Habana	1780	Lost at the waters off Valencia, march 15th, 1799, chased by british ships. Cpt. Jose de la Encina.
Santa Elena	34	El Ferrol	1783	Chased by a british frigate & a SoL, run ashore at Conil, apr 26th, 1797. Cpt. Juan Carranza.
Santa Catalina	34	La Habana	1787	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1819.
Santa Maria	34	El Ferrol	1785	Wrecked at the Indic Sea, apr 24th 1797 due to a storm. Cpt. Fernando Quintano y Solis.
Santa Leocadia	34	El Ferrol	1787	Lost at the waters off Guayaquil in 1804. Cpt. Antonio de la Barreda.
Santa Paula	34	?	1780	Captured to the british by Cordoba's fleet. Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1794.
Santa Perpetua	34	El Ferrol	1772	Out of navy list in 1808.
Santa Teresa (1st)	34	Guarnizo	1768	Exchanged to the Kingdom of Naples by the SoL San Isidoro in 1777.
Santa Teresa (2nd)	34	El Ferrol	1787	Captured by 2 british SoL nearby Mallorca, feb, 5th 1799. Cpt. Pablo Perez.
Santa Casilda	34	Cartagena	1784	Broke up at El Ferrol due to lack of careen on 1832.
Santa Brigida	34	Cartagena	1785	Captured by 3 british frigates, near Corrobedos, Galicia, oct 17th, 1799. Cpt. Antonio Pilon.
Santa Florentina	34	Cartagena	1786	Captured by 2 british SoL & a frigate, apr 7th, 1800, near Cape St. Maria. Cpt. Manuel Novales.
Santa Gertrudis	34	Guarnizo	1768	Captured by a british SoL, near by Cape St. Maria, dec 7th, 1804. Cpt. Juan Jose Salomon.
N S de la Soledad	34	Cartagena	1788	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1821.
N S de las Mercedes	34	La Habana	1786	Blew up in action vs. British oct 5th, 1804 at the waters off Cadiz. Cpt. Jose Manuel de Goicoa.
Palas	34	El Ferrol	1789	Out of navy list in 1798.
Juno	34	El Ferrol	1789	Wrecked due to bad conditions from Puerto Rico to Cadiz in oct 1802. Cpt. Juan Ignacio Bustillos.
Santa Escolastica	34	El Ferrol	1778	Out of navy list in 1800
Wichen-comb	34	?	1780	Captured by Cordoba's fleet. Broke up at Cadiz in 1794.
Mahonesa	34	Mahon	1789	Captured by the british, oct 13rd, 1796.
Perla	34	Cartagena	1789	Right now (1850) in commission at Rio de la Plata, Argentina
Santa Clara	34	El Ferrol	1784	Captured by the british on oct 5th, 1804 at the waters off Cadiz (in peace). Cpt. Diego Aleson.
Tetis	44	El Ferrol	1793	Captured by the british at Corrobedos oct 17th, 1799. FCpt. Juan Mendoza y Moscoso
Pomona	40	El Ferrol	1794	Captured at La Habana by the british aug 23rd, 1806. Died FCpt. Pedro Sanguineto.
Flora	44	El Ferrol	1795	By Royal Order, broke up at Montevideo on april 1812
Medea	44	El Ferrol	1799	Captured by the british off Cadiz on oct 3rd, 1804. Cpt. Francisco Piedrola.

Prueba	44	El Ferrol	1800	Handed in by his Cpt. D. Jose Villegas to Peru rebels on 1821
Anfitrite	40	La Habana	1797	Captured by a british SoL & a frigate 2 days after leaving Cadiz on nov 19th, 1804. Died FCpt. Juan Jose Varela y Ulloa.
Gloria	44	La Habana	1793	Broke up at La Habana due to lack of careen on 1804.
Ceres	44	La Habana	1794	Broke up at El Ferrol by Royal Order of may 12nd, 1804.
Minerva	44	La Habana	1791	Broke up at La Habana due to lack of careen on 1808.
Fama	34	Cartagena	1793	Captured by the british off Cadiz on oct 3rd, 1804. Cpt. Miguel de Zapiain.
Preciosa	34	Cadiz	1791	Wrecked due to a storm at gulf of Lyon, nov 22nd, 1793. FCpt. Luis de Flores.
Esmeralda	34	Mahon	1791	Captured by Peru rebels, at El Callao, nov 5th, 1820 under white flag. Cpt. D. Luis Coig
Venganza	34	Mahon	1793	Handed in by his FCpt. D. Jose Maria Soroa to Peru rebels on 1821
Diana	34	Mahon	1792	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1833.
Ninfa	34	Mahon	1794	Captured by the british off Conil, apr 26th, 1797. FCpt. D. Ignacio Founegra
Proserpina	34	Mahon	1797	Sunk at La Carraca, Cadiz, alone due to lack of careen on 1816.
Sirena	34	Captured	1793	Built at Rochefort. Captured to the french nearby Sardinia by Borja's fleet in 1793. Broke up at Cartagena in 1807.
Ifigenia	34	Captured	1793	Captured to french by Langara's fleet at Mediterranean in 1793. Lost at the waters off Campeche on 1818. Cpt. Alejo Gutierrez de Rubalcaba.
Hermione	34	Captured	?	Ex british, handed in by his crew at Cartagena de Indias on ?. Captured by the british at Porto Cabello 1807. FCpt. Ramon Echaz
Lealtad	50	El Ferrol	1825	Lost at the waters off Santander by a hurricane, jan 13rd, 1834. Brigadier D. Jose Morales de los Rios.
Iberia	50	El Ferrol	1825	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen on 1830.
Restauracion	50	El Ferrol	1826	Ex Villa de Bilbao. Disarmed at la Carraca, Cadiz. Beeing used as mast-machine (1850)
Aretusa	40	Bourdeaux	1819	Bought by the spanish navy in 1819. Broke up at La Habana due to useless in 1829.
Cortes	44	El Ferrol	1836	Armed (in commission 1850) and has to pass from Apostadero (?) to Rio de la Plata (Argentina).
Isabel II	44	El Ferrol	1836	Armed (in commission in 1850) at Cadiz.
Cristina	52	El Ferrol	1837	Armed (in commission in 1850) at La Habana.
Esperanza	50	Cavite	1834	Armed (in commission in 1850) at Cadiz.
Luisa Fernanda	24	La Habana	1845	Armed (in commission in 1850) at La Habana.
Villa de Bilbao	30	London	1846	Built at London under supervision of General D. Casimiro Vigodet. Armed (in commission in 1850) at Cadiz.
Ferrolana	30	El Ferrol	1848	Launched at the begging of 1848, right now (1850) been fitted for commission at El Ferrol
