Salvador del Mundo	112	Ferrol	1787	Captured by the british at Cape St. Vicent feb 14th 1797.Died Cpt. Antonio Yepes.
Real Carlos	112	La Habana	1787	Blow up july 12nd, 1801 after all night fight with San Hermenegildo.Died Cpt. Jose Ezquerria.

Mejicano	112	La Habana	1786	Broke up at El Ferrol for Royal Order of oct 8th, 1813

Rayo	94	La Habana	1749	Lost after battle of Trafalgar, oct 23rd, 1805. Cpt. Enrique Macdonell
San Nicolas	80	Cartagena	1769	Captured by the british at Cape St. Vicent feb 14th 1797.Died Cpt. Tomas Geraldino
San Vicente	80	Cartagena	1768	Set on fire at Trinidad feb 16th, 1797 to avoid capture by british. Adm. Sebastian Ruis de Apocada and Cpt. Geronimo Gonzalez de Mendoza
San Rafael	80	La Habana	1771	Captured by the british at the battle of Cape Finisterre, jul 22nd 1805. Wonded Cpt. Francisco Montes
Bahama	74	La Habana	1784	Captured by the british at Trafalgar, later wrecked due to damages. Died Dionisio Alcala Galiano
San Damaso	74	Cartagena	1776	Set on fire by spanish at Trinidad to avoid captured but fire was set off and captured feb, 16th 1797.
San Agustin	74	Guarnizo	1768	Sunk at Trafalgar, oct 21st 1805, wonded his Cpt. Felip J. Cagigal
San Sebastian	74	Pasajes	1783	Sold to the french on may 1799. Handed in at Cadiz.
Africa	74	Cadiz	1752	Broke up at Cadiz on 1809
Galicia	74	La Habana	1750	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1797
Arrogante	74	Guarnizo	1754	Set on fire at Trinidad feb 16th, 1797 to avoid capture by british. Cpt. Rafael Benasar
Magnanimo	74	Ferrol	1754	Lost at Sisarga, jul 12nd 1794. Cpt. Ramon Topete.
Oriente	74	Ferrol	1753	Broke up at El Ferrol due to lack of careen on 1806
San Eugenio	74	Ferrol	1775	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen on 1804
San Fermin	74	Pasajes	1782	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen on 1808
San Gabriel	74	Ferrol	1772	Sunk at Cadiz due to lack of careen on 1808
Santa Isabel	74	Cartagena	1767	Broke up at La Habana due to lack of careen on 1803
San Isidro	74	Ferrol	1768	Captured by the british at Cape St. Vincent, feb 14th 1797. Cpt. Teodoro Argumosa
San Joaquin	74	Cartagena	1771	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1817
San Juan Nepomuceno	74	Guarnizo	1766	Captured by the british at Trafalgar, oct 21st 1805. Died Cpt. Cosme Damian Churruca
San Justo	74	Cartagena	1779	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1828
Serio	74	Guarnizo	1754	Broke up at El Ferrol due to lack of careen in 1805
San Pedro Apostol	74	Ferrol	1770	Sunk at Manila harbour because bad state to do shipyard?
San Telmo	74	Ferrol	1788	Departed from Cadiz to Lima in 1819 and was lost at Cape Horns? Cpt. Rosendo Perlier
Europa	74	Ferrol	1789	Suffered a storm and was so bad that was sunk at Manila harbour in 1803 to do shipyard?
Angel	74	Cartagena	1773	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1810
Atlante	74	Cartagena	1751	Handed in to France sep 22nd 1801 because of Royal Order from march 31st 1801. Was taken by Cpt. Mr. Villegris.
Brillante	74	Ferrol	1754	Set on fire oct 10th 1790 at Cartagena.
Firme	74	Cadiz	1754	Captured by the british at the battle of Cape Finisterre, jul 22nd 1805. Cpt. Rafael Villavicencio
Gallardo	74	Ferrol	1754	Set on fire at Trinidad feb 16th, 1797 to avoid capture by british. Cpt. Gabriel Sorondo
Glorioso	74	Ferrol	1754	Broke up at Cartagena due to Royal Order of may, 5th 1818
Guerrero	74	Ferrol	1755	Actually its disarmed at El Ferrol (actually = 1850!)
San Antonio	74	Cartagena	1783	Handed in to France may 23rd 1801 because of Royal Order from march 31st 1801. Was taken by Cpt. Mr. Dumanoir
San Francisco de Asis	74	Guarnizo	1767	Sunk the day after Trafalgar due to the storm, oct 23rd 1805. Cpt. Luis de Florez
San Genaro	74	Cartagena	1766	Handed in to France jul 24th 1801 because of Royal Order from march 31st 1801. Was taken by Cpt. Mr. Dumanoir
San Ildefonso	74	Cartagena	1785	Captured by the british at Trafalgar, oct 21st 1805. Wounded Cpt. Jose de Vargas y Varaes
San Juan Bautista	74	Cartagena	1772	Sunk at Cadiz due to lack of careen on 1809
San Lorenzo	74	Guarnizo	1768	Sunk at La Habana due to lack of careen in 1815
San Pablo	74	Ferrol	1771	Renamed Soberano, still In commision (1850) at La Habana.
San Pascual	74	Guarnizo	1767	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1797
Terrible	74	Cartagena	1754	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1811

Triunfante	74	Ferrol	1756	Lost at Bay of Rosas due to a storm. Cpt. Juan Vicente Yañez
Vencedor	74	Ferrol	1755	Handed to France in 1806. Captured by Spain in 1808. Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen..
San Francisco de Paula	74	Cartagena	1788	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1820
Velasco	74	Cartagena	1764	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1797.
España	68	Cadiz	1757	Broke up at Vigo in 1809 because of Royal Order of oct 12nd, 1807
San Isidoro	68	Naples	1766	Wrecked near Palamos oct 26 1794. Cpt. Jose de la Valeta.
Santo Domingo	68	Ferrol	1781	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1807
San Ramon	68	La Habana	1773	Set ashore at the beach in Cadiz because of a storm. Was set on fire by the french in 1810. Cpt. Fernando Bustillo
San Felipe	68	Ferrol	1781	Sold to the dutch for 65,000 pesos sencillos because of Royal Order of jul 8th, 1794
America	68	La Habana	1766	Sold at Cadiz for firewood in 1823
San Pedro de Alcantara	64	La Habana	1788	Burnt at Coche Island in 1815. Cpt. Jose Maria Salazar
San Leandro	64	Ferrol	1787	Sunk at La Habana due to lack of careen in 1813
San Fulgencio	64	Cartagena	1787	Sunk at La Habana due to lack of careen in 1814
Astuto	58	La Habana	1758	Broke up at Cartagena due to lack of careen in 1810
Castilla	58	Ferrol	1780	Hulked at Cadiz. Went ashore in 1810 due to a storm and was set on fire by the french.
Peruano	58	Guayaquil	1750	Sold because of Royal Order from jan 26th, 1790
San Julian	58	Cartagena	1781	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1830
Miño	54	Ferrol	1779	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1813
La Ferme	74	?	1794	Handed in by the Royalist french at La Habana to Spain in 1794. Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1808
Reina Luisa (Fernando VII)	112	El Ferrol	1791	Wrecked due to a storm at cape Bujia, north of Argel, dec 9th, 1815. Ctp. Manuel Posadas
Principe de Asturias	112	La Habana	1794	Sunked at La Habana due to lack of careen in 1814.
Intrepido	74	El Ferrol	1790	Tranfered to France on jul, 1st 1804 by Royal Order of march 31st, 1804. Taken by Contre Admiral Dumanoir.
Infante Don Pelayo	74	La Habana	1791	Tranfered to France on apr, 23rd 1802 at Brest.
Neptuno	74	El Ferrol	1795	Wrecked at the waters off Port of St. Maria, near Cadiz after the battle of Trafalgar, oct 23rd, 1805. Brigadier D. Cayetano Valdes (wounded).
Montañes	74	El Ferrol	1794	Run ashore at the waters off Port Real, Cadiz, mar 9th, 1810 due to a heavy storm. After was burnt by french troops. Brigad. D. Jose de Quevedo
Conquistador	74	Cartagena	1794	Transferred to France on apr 23rd, 1802 at Brest
Monarca	74	El Ferrol	1794	Wrecked on oct 23rd, 1805 after the battle of Trafalgar. Cpt. Teodoro Argumosa
Argonauta	74	El Ferrol	1796	Wrecked at the battle of Trafalgar, oct 21st, 1805. Cpt. D. Antonio Pareja (wounded)
Soberano	74	La Habana	1794	Broke up at Cadiz in 1804
Asia	68	La Habana	1790	Handed in to Peru revels on mar 10th, 1825 at Guajan island. When to Veracruz and sunk on 1830 due to lack of careen.
Heroe	80	Captured	1808	Built at Rochefort. Beeing broke up at El Ferrol due to bad conditions (1850)
Algeciras	74	Captured	1808	Sunk at La Carraca between 1818-1819. Was recovered and taken to a dry dockyard in 1825 to be careen. Broke up in 1828-29.
Pluton (Montañes)	74	Captured	1808	Broke up at Cadiz due to lack of careen in 1816
